RE: CVWD's Comments to LAFCO's revised final Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update for the Congress Valley Water District.

## Dear Brendon:

Please find below the Congress Valley Water District (CVWD) Board of Directors' comments and suggested revisions to the revised/final Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update for CVWD.

- (1) Section II.A.3(d): Delete "from a water provider" and replace with "in accordance with G.C. Section 56133.5".
- (2) Section II.A.5(a): Delete entirely and replace with "CVWD and the City of Napa each owns a water system. The terms of their existing Water Supply Contract, as amended, governs their relationship with respect to their water systems." (See Recitals A and B to Water Supply Contract).
- (3) Section II.A.6(a): Delete 3<sup>rd</sup> sentence and replace with "Provision of water service within the CVWD boundaries is governed by the terms of the Water Supply Contract between CVWD and the City of Napa."
- (4) Section II.A.6(b): 1<sup>st</sup> sentence: delete "over a half a century ago" and replace with "in 1949". 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence: Add "existing" before "water supply contract"; add "and revised in 2016" after 1980's.
- (5) Section II.A.6(d): Add at beginning of section, "As set forth in the First Amendment to the Water Supply Contract between the City of Napa and CVWD,".

- (6) Section III.1.0: Delete Tim Josten as Board Member, and add Roland Cavanagh. Delete officer titles.
- (7) Section III.3.3: In 2<sup>nd</sup> Paragraph, delete 4<sup>th</sup> sentence, "CVWD and the City contemplated the extension of public water service to these nine parcels at the time the contract was initiated."
- (8) Section IV.A.1.0: Remove from 3<sup>rd</sup> sentence in the "Present and Probable Need for Public Facilities and Services" section, the phrase "and indicates the City and CVWD contemplated the eventual extension of water service to the area".
- (9) Section IV. A. 2.0: Under "Present and Planned Land Use" section, 2<sup>nd</sup> Paragraph: delete the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence reading "There are no current plans to further develop any properties or intensify uses within the Old Sonoma Road Study Area."
- (10) Section IV. A. 2.0: Under "Present and Planned Land Use" section, 3<sup>rd</sup> Paragraph: In the last sentence, refer to negative declaration "at a minimum" or add "or Environmental Impact Report".
- (11) Section IV. A. 2.0: Under "Present and Probable Need for Public Facilities and Services" section, 1<sup>st</sup> Paragraph: Please cite sources for statement that annual water demands within the Old Sonoma Road Study Area total approximately 42.0 acre-feet.
- (12) Figure Two: Remove "Congress Valley Water District Outside Water Connections" label from the southern-most area labeled as such below the Buhman Avenue line. This area is not a CVWD outside water connection. It is served by the City of Napa.

Thank you for your cooperation with our requests for redlined versions of the various drafts that were sent out for comment. You mentioned that a map had been removed from the September 27, 2017 draft, but we do not see which map was removed. Thank you for any clarification you can provide.
